IHP is supporting TLM, Tanzania's only specialist paediatric oncology programme. TLM is working to turn around the 12% survival rate for childhood cancer. To achieve this TLM is increasing outreach programmes, devising national treatment guidelines and thanks to their partnership with IHP can offer free, long dated and effective medicines.

So far Accord have donated 11 lines of treatment towards TLM totalling 22,786 treatments on the ground.
